## PROCEEDINGS OF THE DIRECTOR OF MATRICULATION SCHOOLS, CHENNAI

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- Sub: School Education Matriculation Schools Closure of school – Palaniappa Matriculation Higher Secondary School, Mamara Thottam, Avinashi, Thiruppur District – Orders issued – Regarding.
- Ref: 1. Letter dated 27.01.2022 of the Correspondent, Palaniappa Matriculation Higher Secondary School, Mamara Thottam, Avinashi, Thiruppur District 2. Letter Rc. No. 2307/A3/2022, dated 03.03.2022 of the Chief Educational Officer, Thiruppur.

Palaniappa Matriculation Higher Secondary School, Mamara Thottam, Avinashi, Thiruppur District was accorded renewal of recognition for classes LKG to 12<sup>th</sup> Standard upto 31.05.2022. With reference to the letter first cited the Correspondent of the school has requested to issue closure order for the school. A resolution to this effect has been passed in the Trust Board Meeting as well as consent has been obtained from the parents of the school.

The Chief Educational Officer, Thiruppur his letter second cited has recommended for the closure of school.

The request of the Correspondent and also the recommendation of the Chief Educational Officer were carefully considered by the undersigned and the closure Palaniappa Matriculation Higher Secondary School, Mamara Thottam, Avinashi, Thiruppur District is allowed with the following conditions:

- The school management / Educational Agency of the Palaniappa Matriculation Higher Secondary School, Mamara Thottam, Avinashi, Thiruppur District is strictly instructed to issue Transfer Certificate to LKG to 8, 12<sup>th</sup> Standard students on roll as on 31.05.2022.
- 2. It is instructed not to continue with any class after 31.05.2022 except 9<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> Standard.
- 3. The Affiliation Bye-Laws 2018 of the Central Board of Secondary Education under Rule 2.4.13 provides withdrawal of students in a phased manner in respect of school already affiliated with other Board. Hence, for the welfare of students studying in 9<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> Standards, the school is permitted to continue to function upto the academic year 2024-2025 with classes 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> to write their Board Examination.

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- 4. All the permanent records such as Admission Register, Transfer Certificate Counterfoils, Attendance Register, Salary Accquitance etc., shall be submitted to the Chief Educational Officer on the closure of the school.
- 5. The school management shall take the responsibility of continuing the studies of the children admitted under the provisions of Section 12 (1) (c) of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 in the school proposed to be opened by the Management under affiliation to the Central Board of Secondary Education.
- 6. The school management shall apply for continuation of recognition to the Chief Educational Officer, Thiruppur.
- 7. In case of any complaint received or any cases filed against the closure of the school, the school management is fully responsible for the same.
- 8. The students shall not be affected by the course of closure of the school.

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The above recognition is subject to the following conditions:-

- (1) The temporary recognition accorded to the school is valid upto **31.05.2024** and is to be renewed at an interval of every three years.
- (2) The grant of recognition is available initially for classes LKG to VIII Std and to be extended for Secondary / Senior Secondary Classes subsequently in due course of time.
- (3) The School shall abide by the provisions of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 and the Tamil Nadu Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011.
- (4) The School shall admit in pre-school / class I to the extent of 25% of the strength in each class, children belonging to Weaker Section and Disadvantaged Group in the neighborhood and provide free and compulsory elementary education till its completion.
- (5) The School shall maintain a separate bank account for the purpose of reimbursement.
- (6) The School shall not collect any capitation fee and subject the child or his or her parent or guardian to any screening procedure.
- (7) The School shall not deny admission to any child, -
  - (a) for lack of age proof if such admission is sought subsequent to the extended period prescribed for admission.
  - (b) on the ground of religion, caste or race, place of birth or any of them.

(8) The School shall ensure that,-


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- no child admitted shall be held back in any class or expelled from School till the completion of elementary education in a school;
- (ii) no child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment.
- (iii) no child is required to pass any board examination till the completion of elementary education;
- (iv) every child completing elementary education shall be awarded a certificate as laid down under rule 21.
- inclusion of students with disabilities / special needs as per provision of the Act.
- (vi) the teachers are recruited with minimum qualifications as laid under section 23(1) of the Act: Provided that the teachers who, at the commencement of this Act do not possess minimum qualifications shall acquire such minimum qualifications within a period of 5 years;
- (vii) the teacher performs his duties specified under sub-section (1) of section 24 of the Act; and
- (viii) the teacher shall not engage himself for private teaching activities.
- (9) The School shall follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum laid down by appropriate authority.
- (10) The School shall maintain the standards and norms as specified in section 19 of the Act.
- (11) No unrecognized classes shall run within the premises of the school or outside in the name of School.

- (12) The school building plan must have been approved by the current rules or G.Os. The School building or other structures and the grounds are used only for the purposes of education and skill development. Construction work within the compound should not be carried out in school working hours and safety measures in all respects are the whole responsibility of the managements.
- (13) The School is run by a society registered under the Tamil Nadu Societies Registration Act, 1975 (Tamil Nadu Act 27 of 1975), or a public trust constituted under any law for the time being in force;
- (14) The School is not run for profit to any individual, group or association of individuals or any other persons;
- (15) The accounts should be audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper accounts statements should be prepared. A copy each of the Statements of Accounts should be sent every year to the competent authority granting recognition.
- (16) The recognition Code Number shall be quoted for any correspondence with the competent authority.
- (17) The School shall furnish such reports and information as may be required by the competent authority from time to time and shall comply with such instructions of the State Government or the competent authority as may be issued to secure the continued fulfillment of the condition of recognition or the removal of deficiencies in working of the School;
- (18) Tamil shall be taught as a subject from in Standards I to X in all schools notified under sub clause (iv) of clause (e) of section 2 of the Tamil Nadu Tamil Learning Act, 2006 (Tamil Nadu Act 13 of 2006) in a phased manner Commencing from the academic year 2015-2016 for standard I, from the Academic year 2016-2017 for standard I and II and shall be extended up to Standard X in a like manner as ordered in a reference (5) cited as Follows:

- (19) The school shall abide by the provisions of the Tamil Nadu Recognized Private Schools (Regulation) Act 1973 and Tamil Nadu Recognized Private Schools (Regulation) Rules 1974.
- (20) The certificates of recognition issued by the department shall be subject to the fulfillment of deficiencies if any pointed out by the department at any stage/time.
- (21) The management shall rectify the deficiencies pointed out in infrastructure or administration by the authorities.
- (22) The Management shall apply for renewal of recognition three months before the expiry of this order to this Directorate through the Chief Educational Officer of the district concerned.
- (23) The management shall follow the directions issued by the Government/Department from time to time keeping in view of the safety and security of the children and the overall administration of the School.
- (24) The recognition shall be withdrawn if any contravention of the provisions of the Act, Rules or the conditions of recognition are found and proved.
- (25) The School Management Shall have to full responsibility if any court case arise this regard. This order may be used only for the purpose of seeking affiliation to Central Board of Secondary Education as requested by the management and the management is not entitled to seek affiliation to any other Board.
